Airboats

Have you ever wanted to go through the wetlands to see all the different animals, but just didn't know how? The solution is to take an airboat tour! Airboats are ATV's (all-terrain vehicles). They can be used to travel through tall grass, marsh, water, dry ground, dirt roads, ice, and snow. Since they can carry about 12 people, you can even bring all your friends!

Airboats can go over 135 miles an hour on smooth, shallow water and can reach this speed in only 4 seconds. That's fast! However they generally don't have brakes, so airboat drivers have to be very careful when traveling at high speeds.

Most airboats are built with automotive engines, so if your airboat breaks down, you can take it to your mechanic and they'll be able to fix it, no problem. So the next time you have some free time on your hands and you don't know what to do, take an airboat tour through the wetlands. It's fun and educational!
